Major Trauma Fast Beep System

Dial 2222

STANDBY CALLS – ASK SAS FOR PULSE AND BP

✓ Stabbing and SBP <100 any time or p>110

✓ Stand-by for fall from a height

✓ Trauma & Cardiac Arrest

✓ Stand-by for RTA / entrapment / ejection

✓ All GSW

✓ Major Mechanism of Injury & Multiple Injuries

Who can request

Senior ED Doctor

Who should respond

Surgical Registrar (p13436)

Surgical SHO (p13288)

ITU SHO/Registrar (p13002)

2nd on Anaesthetist

Ensure ED Consultant informed if Out of Hours

Notes

Surgical registrar should carry the 13436 page at all times (24hrs)

If there is any difficulty with the registrar responding - don't waste time continuously paging 13436.

The surgical SHO should be very quickly briefed on the situation and *should* be able to locate a senior surgeon.

The on-call surgical team may be in theatre at ext 25022.

If the duty team are unable to attend during the day, there will always be surgeons in other theatres and doing out-patient clinics.
