

## Gender determination at 20 week Fetal Anomaly Scan

You have asked that we reveal our assessment of your baby's gender.

It should be noted that our sonographers are principally scanning for abnormalities and that they will not always be in a position to determine the baby's gender and cannot prolong a scan to determine this. Your baby must be in a position where gender can be easily identifiable.

Ultrasound is not 100% accurate in determining fetal gender. The Sonographer or NHS GG&C is not liable should an inaccurate gender determination be made.
