Important Information for Nursing Staff

- This titration regime is available as a preset protocol on HEPMA and should be used as standard.
- If this form is used instead of the preset protocol it must also be prescribed by medical staff on HEPMA under 'Clozapine loading regime- as charted'
- Nursing staff must monitor for effect and side effects during titration [monitor blood pressure, pulse, respiration and temperature] and liaise with medical staff accordingly.
- * Should it be deemed necessary that a slower titration is required, the blank titration regime may be used. Alternatively, this regime can be discontinued on HEPMA and clozapine should then be prescribed as all other medications are prescribed and prescription dosages altered when required.
- After initial 15-day titration is complete, clozapine can then be prescribed routinely on HEPMA.

- This regime should be kept within the treatment room and be available at the time of administration whilst in use then filed in case notes when complete.
- All nursing staff must be aware of side effects of clozapine & to be alert for signs and symptoms of infections, refer to GG&C clozapine standards at all times.
