## **Important Information for Nursing Staff**

- This titration regimen is used to create a personalized schedule to initiate clozapine for relevant patients.
- This titration regime must also be prescribed by medical staff on HEPMA under 'Clozapine loading regime- as charted'
- Nursing staff must monitor for effect and side effects during titration [monitor blood pressure, pulse, respiration and temperature] and liaise with medical staff accordingly.
- After initial 15-day titration is complete, clozapine can then be prescribed routinely on HEPMA. Doses should be increased at a rate and by increments based on the response to treatment and tolerability.
- This regime should be kept within the treatment room and be available at the time of administration whilst in use then filed in case notes when complete.
- All nursing staff must be aware of side effects of clozapine & to be alert for signs and symptoms of infections, refer to <a href="GG&C clozapine standards">GG&C clozapine standards</a> at all times.
