

NEW Unlicensed Medicines Policy and Process - November 2024

The previous NHS Lanarkshire Unlicensed Medicines Policy has expired and has been updated with a new policy and associated appendices, flowcharts and processes. This policy provides information on unlicensed medicines, off-label use of licensed medicines and the corresponding responsibilities of prescribers and pharmacy. It also discusses the processes prescribers should follow when considering the use of unlicensed medicines. It can be found here: Unlicensed-Medicines-Policy | NHS Lanarkshire

Key changes to the new unlicensed medicines policy are:

- ✓ All paperwork has been updated and streamlined for use across all locations in NHS Lanarkshire.
- ✓ The distinction between unlicensed and off-label medicines has been clarified along with the different processes required.
- ✓ A cost consideration element has been incorporated into the decision making process.
- ✓ The approval process has been clarified for acute & primary care
- ✓ Additional considerations have been incorporated for clinical areas including palliative care, paediatrics & mental health.
- ✓ A central R drive folder has been developed for use across all sites to allow sharing of key documents and consolidation and oversight of unlicensed medicines approval across the Board.




