CAUDA EQUINA PATHWAY

We realise the process of identifying a patient with CES can appear daunting and following the pathway can appear complex. This Infographic breaks down the process, making it easier to understand and follow with embedded links (red writing or images) to relevant paperwork. Discuss on site and escalate as per pathway. Onwards referral does not need to be agreed by the Low Back Pain APP's.
