## MAJOR TRAUMA WARD REFERRAL FROM QEUH ED



- Injuries > 1 body region & require in-patient care\* from > 1 specialty
- Significant injury to a single body region eg:
  - High energy pelvic fractures
  - Chest wall injuries
  - High energy open long bone fractures
- Multiply-injured patients requiring single specialty input but who would benefit from the specialist nursing and rehabilitation specialists available via the MTW
- Non trauma call patients with the above injuries can also be admitted to the MTW, please discuss with the MTW team
   \* Care = surgical intervention or ongoing review, monitoring and investigation.

## **Excludes**

- Patients with an isolated head injury
- Patients with a single system injury that can be managed by a single specialty that do not meet the above criteria
- Patients requiring critical care support
