Cefotaxime

INDICATION A broad-spectrum antibiotic with activity against both Gram-negative and

Gram-positive bacteria. In the neonatal unit it is mainly used for the

treatment of meningitis.

Remember fungal prophylaxis.

DOSE RANGE

AGE	DOSE	FREQUENCY	ROUTE
0 – 6 days	25mg/kg/dose	12 hourly	IV
7 – 21 days	25mg/kg/dose	8 hourly	IV
> 21 days	25mg/kg/dose	8 hourly (increased to 6 hourly in severe infections)	IV

^{*}doses can be doubled to 50mg/kg/dose in severe infections

Dosage interval should be increased in babies with severe renal failure (serum creatinine >200 µmol/l)

FORM Vial containing 500 mg powder for reconstitution OR Vial containing 1000 mg powder for reconstitution

RECONSTITUTION 500mg vial: Add 4.8mL of water for injection to a 500mg vial to give a

100mg/mL solution

1000mg vial: Add 9.6mL of water for injection to a 1000mg vial to give a

100mg/mL solution

Shake well to reconstitute the dry powder.

METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION

Standard dose: 25mg/kg/dose - Slow IV bolus over 3 minutes

Double dose: 50mg/kg/dose – Short IV infusion over 30 minutes

and frusemide.
