## Support for clinical guideline development

NHSGGC has a variety of teams who can support clinical guideline development, including:

- Medical Illustration: support may be sought to produce flowcharts, diagrams, etc. Please note that it is not a requirement of clinical guideline development for the document to be formatted by medical illustration and word remains the preferred format for submission.

The NHSGGC Library Network offers a range of one to one support at any stage of clinical guideline development or review, including:

- Professional searches & synthesis of the literature, including keeping up to date alerts, requests can be placed via Knowledge Services on <u>eHelp</u>
- Visualisation of guidelines or protocols using Clinical Knowledge Publisher or the Right Decision Service
- Searches to investigate copyright permissions for diagnostic tools and outcome measures, obtaining (where possible) permission for NHSGGC staff to continue to use them, see our catalogue of Tools and Measures <u>here</u>
- Advice and training on carrying out searches and critically appraising the evidence, to request training visit Knowledge Services on <u>eHelp</u>
- Support and advice on managing references using online reference management software <u>Refworks</u>
- Advice on using electronic journals and accessing full text on the <u>Knowledge Network and Library</u> <u>Search</u>
