- Patient admitted from (home, care home, transferring hospital, other)
- Referral diagnosis
- Post take ward round diagnosis if applicable
- Cause of death

# Mortality review findings

- 1. Was there an intervention(s) which could have been made anytime prior to the patient's death that potentially could have impacted on the patient's outcome?
- 2. What do the findings tell us about our systems?

#### Highlight any issues with:

- Diagnostics
- Treatment
- Communication
- Recognise or rescue
- Scope of care
- Other (patient fall in hospital, hospital acquired pressure sore, hospital acquired infection, hospital acquired DVT, readmission within 30 days)
- Were there concerns about the pre hospital care? (including primary care, ambulance, emergency department)

## **Summary**

Which statement best describes the management of this case?

- There were no areas of concern
- There were areas of concerns but they made no difference to the actual outcome
- There were areas of concerns which may have contributed to the actual outcome
- There were areas of concerns which caused the outcome which would otherwise not have been expected to occur.
