Consider Contacting Parent/carer directly to discuss/arrange visit

No Concerns/ no need for follow up appt Discharged

Letter sent to parent/carer and GP/Referrer. Copies to involved professionals as necessary.

Concerns Identified

Referral to Children and Families Duty Social Work 01896 662787.

If child/YP/unborn on Child Protection Register or has social work involvement inform allocated social worker.

Immediate concern of significant risk contact Police Scotland 999.

Inform Referrer/GP/other involved professionals as appropriate.

Plan contact dependent on level of concern/need.

Consider need for MAC/Universal plus meeting to support child/YP/Family.

Seek Advice/consultation from NHS Borders Public Protection Team.

Child Was Not Brought to 2nd
Appointment

Health Professional decision regarding need to reappoint to be based on clinical need/risk and Welfare or Child Protection risk- Inform Key/lead professional/referrer.

Child Was Not Brought to 3rd
Appointment

Seek further information/support from other professionals involved in care.

Consider need for MAC/Universal plus meeting to support child/YP/Family.

Child discharged back to care of GP/referrer – letter sent to parents and all involved professionals as appropriate.
